Dear Parents and Caregivers,

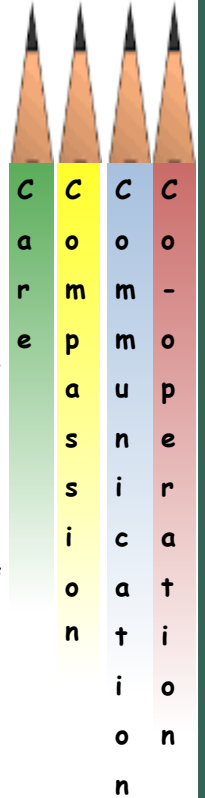

PARENT SURVEY

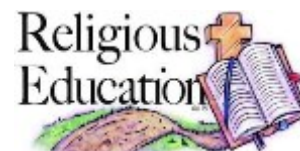
Dear Parents and Carers
