ENGLISH

<u>Reading</u> - The children will be reading levelled readers in guided reading and reciprocal reading groups. Your child will participate in guided reading lessons to explicitly teach reading strategies and comprehension skills. They will be regularly monitored and assessed to ensure that they are being challenged and supported. Fluency and an understanding of the text at literal and inferential level for both fiction and factual texts are crucial in their progression as a reader.

<u>Writing</u> - Students in Year 2 we will explore writing imaginative, informative and persuasive texts throughout the year. They will use a variety of stimuli to help them develop ideas for their writing.

MATHEMATICS

Throughout the year we will work towards outcomes from the various Mathematics strands: Number and Algebra, Statistics and Probability and Measurement and Geometry.

The Mathematics block is set up into three main components:

- 1. Warm up (with a specific focus on number building)
- 2. Rich open-ended task mixed ability groups and investigations
- 3. Reflection time students explain their thinking and the teacher summarises the main teaching points. We always ask the question: How did you work that out?

COMMUNICATION

There are many forms of communication between school and home. Notes from home are to be handed to the class teacher in the morning. ABSENCES

If your child is absent from school this absence needs to be explained the following day. The reason for the absence is then recorded on the electronic roll, which is a legal document. The explanation can be made via a note written to the teacher, an email to the school, Skoolbaq App or a phone call to the school office.

PARENT HELPERS

At this stage we will not be requiring volunteer helpers. However should an occasion arise that we do, the class teacher will distribute a letter asking for volunteers.

HOMEWORK

Homework differs from year to year. In Year 2, students are expected to READ every night. They can read any text they choose. Books/readers sent from school are just a courtesy. For mathematics the students will have access to an online website called 'Studyladder'. This will have a range of tasks that your child can complete at their own pace. While reading every night is an expectation, we understand that the families at Corpus Christi participate in a range of extracurricular and sporting activities. Homework needs to be part of a balanced week for your child and should not consume your week. Families can choose whether to do this work on pieces of paper, in a book or on technology (or in any other form appropriate).
