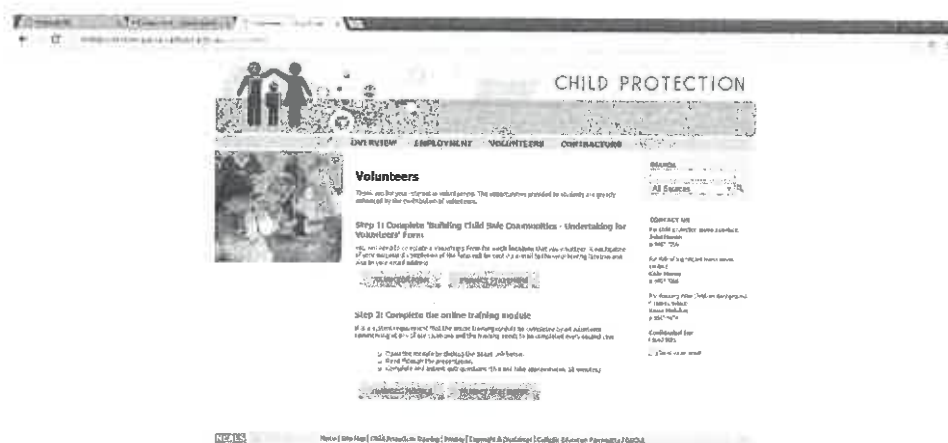


## BUILDING CHILD SAFE COMMUNITIES – NEW FORMS FOR ALL VOLUNTEERS

Building Child Safe Communities' is a new initiative developed by the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta that enhances our commitment to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all students in our care. It is now a requirement that all volunteers complete an online undertaking form that confirms expectations in relation to behaviour whilst volunteering at schools. This undertaking form also seeks to determine the suitability of volunteers by requiring them to declare that they do not have a criminal history involving children.

This new Child Protective Training module is a compulsory two-step process for all volunteers working in our schools and can be accessed via the following link:

- Click onto **VOLUNTEERS**.
- Complete **STEP 1-Volunteer Form**.
- Complete **STEP 2 –Training Module**.
- Read through the presentation.
- Complete and submit the quiz questions.
- After successful completion of both steps, two notifications will be sent via email to the school and also to the volunteer's email address.

Following your completion of the online form, a register of all volunteers will be kept at the school. The Volunteer Form and Training Module will remain valid for two years.
