Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The 3 Way Interviews have nearly concluded at Corpus Christi and they have again, been very successful. The purpose of the interviews is to allow the home and school to sit together and discuss the learning successes and challenges of the students. The outcome of these meetings is that the student needs to reflect on their learning and develop their own learning goals for the coming semester.

As I have been moving around the school during the interview times, I have been talking with parents and children and asking the students about their learning goals for the future semester. Every single student I spoke to were able to demonstrate that they have reflected on their learning situation and could articulate goals that included writing, listening, numeracy, problem solving or social focuses. The older students focusing on writing goals could even articulate what writing cluster they were working towards.

I express my thanks to all the teachers for their preparation for these interviews and the professional way that in which they were conducted. I also thank all families who attended the school for the interviews demonstrating the true home / school partnership that is present at Corpus Christi.

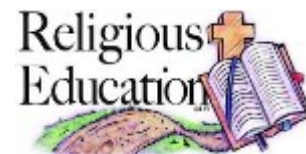

Faith Formation

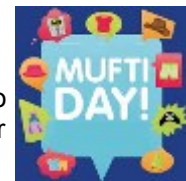
Gospel Mt 10:37-42 Take up your cross.
