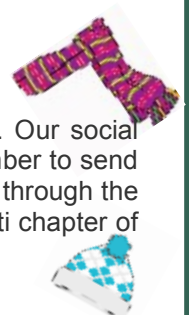

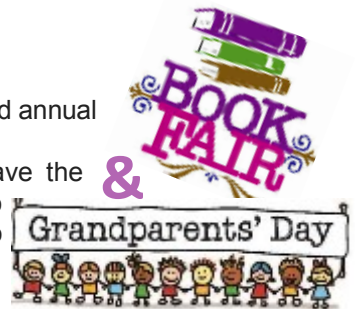
THE KINDERGARTEN JOY COWLEY DAY- Thursday 29th June
