**QUALITY CATHOLIC SCHOOLS SURVEY 2017- MONDAY 20TH - FRIDAY 31ST MARCH**

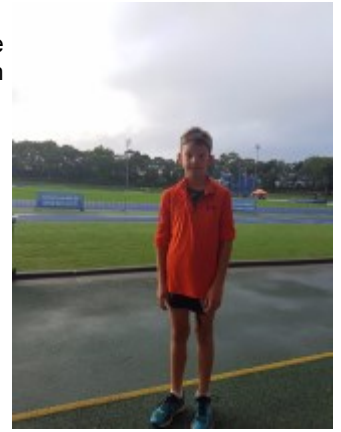
